KATIE COSMETIC SURGERY SHOCK!

KATIE COURIC has seemingly discovered the Fountain of Youth!

At age 56, the newsgal-turned-talk show host looks perkier than ever - but experts believe she's had some surgical assistance in keeping Father Time at bay.

"Katie looks great, but I believe she had help," says Dr. Brian Glatt, a New Jersey cosmetic surgeon associated with the Mount Sinai School of Medicine.

"It looks like she did Botox to the area between her eyes and her forehead, which now have no wrinkles and are completely smooth.

"She may have had a neck-lift as there are bands under the middle of her neck on the older picture. She does appear to have had a full facial resurfacing with either a laser or chemical peel as her entire face seems lighter in color, smoother in texture, and overall shows less irregular hyperpigmentation."

With Botox running \$500 to \$800, neck-lifts from \$5,000 to \$7,500 and chemical peels at \$1,500 to \$3,000 her total make-

over could have cost up to \$18,500!

"What a pleasant change from other celebrities who try too hard to look young and land up looking unnatural," West Palm Beach, Fla., dermatologist Dr. Ken Beer tells GLOBE. "She still looks like Katie!"

And New York cosmetic surgeon Dr. Matthew Schulman tells GLOBE, "Her eyes do appear younger and her eyebrows a little higher than before. She may have had a brow-lift that can be performed through hidden incisions behind the hairline. Katie looks well rested and very natural."
